## GRACE DREYER:

### Fox Lea's 2023 Mini EAP Clinician

Grace Dreyer is a professional rider and trainer working out of Cavallo Farms; owned and operated by Amy Center and Janet Cawley. As a junior rider, Grace not only rode with both Amy and Janet, but also became their working student for many years. During her Junior years at Cavallo Farms, she attended Pony Finals twice and moved successfully into the jumper ring claiming many accolades with her horse Castlebay, whom she still owns today. Together, they competed in the Children's/Adult Jumper Championship in both 2013 and 2014 helping to clinch ribbons for her team. She participated in the USHJA Emerging Athletes Program in 2014 and 2015 where she was immersed in both riding and stable management and rode under Olympic athletes. She spent her first years as a professional working for Cloud Nine Farm and owner/trainer Stevie McCarron Wigley in Lexington, KY. Since starting back at Cavallo Farms in 2017 she has helped produce and coach many riders to their goals including competing at Pony finals, IEA nationals, and Maclay regionals. Grace not only assists with the substantial lesson program at Cavallo Farms, but also helps to maintain a busy show schedule, coaching ringside as well as showing clients horses of all levels.
